



New Brunswick Swimmers at Canadian Age Group Championships July 22 – 26 2010

New Brunswick swimmers returned from the 2010 Canadian Age Group Championships in Winnipeg Manitoba this past weekend with personal best times, 4 top 16 finishes and three top 8 finishes including a gold medal swim from Louis Savoie from CNBO in the 15 yr male 50 m Fly and a new provincial record for Male 15 – 17 in the 50m Breaststroke from Louis Savoie of CNBO

Six New Brunswick Swimmers attended the competition; Marie Pier Daigle from the Bathurst Piranhas (BLAST) competed in 5 events with her best placing in the 50m back. Gabriel Boivin, Madeline Leger, Jean-Luc Martin, Andrew Osborne and Louis Savoie represented the Club de Natation Blue et Or from Moncton. Madeleine Leger competed in six individual events and had personal best times in the 200m Back, 50m Back, 800m Free and 100m Back. Gabriel Boivin (CNBO) had a 15th place finish in the 15 yr Males 800 Free. Jean-Luc Martin (CNBO) had top 16 finishes in the 14 yr Males 50m Breast and 100m Breast. Andrew Osborne had a top 16 finish in the 15yr Males 50m Breast, as well as placing 7th in the 100 Breast and 5th in the 200 Breast. Louis Savoie set a new provincial record in the swim off race for the 50m breast stroke final and earned a 4th place finish in the final of that race. Louis Savoie had a top 16 finish in the 15yr Male 100m Fly. The highlight of the completion was the gold medal swim from Louis Savoie in the 15 yr Male 50m Fly with a personal best time of 26.57 long Course. Congratulation to all of our swimmers .
